It consists of 45 hours of major and professional courses, plus any pre- or corequisite courses that were not taken in the coursework of the previous degree(s). Upon completion of the program and fulfillment of the standards required by the State of Tennessee, candidates may be recommended by the Aquinas College Teacher Education administration and faculty for K-6 licensure.
