POST 9/11 GI Bill (Chapter 33)
Yellow Ribbon Program
Policies and Procedures

The Yellow Ribbon Scholarship is available to individuals entitled to the 100% benefit rate as determined by VA. Student's Certificate of Eligibility from VA must indicate student is eligible for Yellow Ribbon benefits.

Aquinas College has agreed to provide Yellow Ribbon benefits to 8 qualified students for the 2011-2012 academic year.

Benefits are awarded on a first-come-first-served basis, regardless of the rate at which the Student is pursuing training (i.e., full-time versus less than full-time) during the academic year. Determination of first come/first served will be based on date/time the Request For Yellow Ribbon Benefits Application is received by the Registrar's Office. Requests must be received prior to the beginning of classes for each semester.

Aquinas College agrees to contribute up to \$1,550.00 toward tuition and fees for the 2011-2012 academic year. Funds distributed will not exceed amount of tuition and fees charged to student.

If Student withdraws from class(es), applicable tuition and fees will be refunded per the Aquinas College Refund Policy and it will be the student's responsibility to return monies to the Department of Veterans Affairs.

Student will receive contributions during the 2011-2012 academic year and all subsequent years until completion of stated program, provided the Student remains in good academic standing as stated in Aquinas College Catalog.

Attendance at Aquinas College must be continuous (excluding summer terms) until completion of program. If Student withdraws from Aquinas College, his/her Yellow Ribbon benefits for subsequent years will be forfeited.
